Symptoms

Now that we have had some contact with schools with actual cases, it is becoming clearer that headaches, fatigue and sickness are very much the theme in primary children and not particularly the persistent cough and high temperature that is informed. No symptoms at all was equally common.

We are trying to be cautious and ask that if your child is sent home with suspicious symptoms, you go for a test. At least one family have tried that this week and got told they can't get tested, so I suppose it's a bit hit and miss. But where you can get tested, it would put all our minds at rest (see previous headlines).

Morrisons and Free School Meals (FSM)

Morrisons have offered to provide children who get Free School Meals with food if they have to self isolate. For FSM children not at school, we will inform Morrisons who will then deliver a hamper to your door.

In order to do this, you are going to need to fill in the permission form below. We do all the work, you don't need to contact anyone. It does add a significant amount of work for our office staff and I'm not sure what sort of delay there might be once we send the forms off.



This is really meant for those children self isolating for 14 days as it is a weekly delivery from what I understand. The leaflet does say for up to 7 days but the rest of the literature suggests it is weekly. We shall see. Either way I think it is very good of Morrisons to set this up – I hope they are prepared for the numbers.

<u>IMPORTANT</u> – The free meal children get in KSI is <u>NOT</u> the same as Free School Meal. You will know if you are eligible for FSM as you will have applied for it and Staffordshire County Council have informed you that you have got it.

Morrisons Permissions Form – only for parents of children who are Free School Meals /We give permission for the school to provide Morrisons with my child(ren)'s details to receive my Free School Meals should my child(ren) go into self isolation.
